**Subject: Advisory on the matter regarding counselling & admission to undergraduate and postgraduate courses under Ayurveda, Siddha and Unani streams for the A.Y 2024-25-reg.**

**Ref:- Ministry of Ayush (No.L-14030/87/2022-EP-I), letter received through email dated 13.11.2024.**

Madam/Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to convey it is aware that all Central/State/UT counselling Authorities are conducting counselling for admission to UG&PG courses under ASU&H streams for the A.Y 2024-25. As per the directives issued by the NCISM regarding the Central/State/UT counselling 2024, the colleges/Institutes who have received permission from the Medical Assessment and Rating Board/National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) for UG&PG courses under Ayurveda, Siddha and Unani streams for the academic session 2024-25 shall only be eligible to participate in the counselling process.

In this regard, it has come to the our notice that few colleges are participating in the on-going State/UT counselling process based on interim orders issued by various High Courts across the country. Needless to say that the affiliating/examining University shall not allow these students to appear in the examinations, as it might be the case that the final verdict of the Court litigation is awaited during the examination schedule. Also the students' future is at stake until the final decision of the Court in such similar issues. Further, in case the final outcome of the Court is against the candidate/college, candidates shall lose their precious time to grab other career opportunities also.

Therefore, in view of the above facts and in exercise of the powers as conferred under Section 44 of NCISM Act, 2020, the State/UT counselling Authorities are directed to ensure the following instructions:


- i. All Private ASU&H institutions have to display the permission status of the college for the A.Y 2024-25 issued by NCISM on the college's website; they should also display the number of seats obtained through the interim order on the official website along with case detail and latest update of case time to time.



- ii. At the time of allotment, all counselling authorities are instructed to mention the permission status of the college against the available seat matrix of the college and display the same on the counselling authorities' website.
- iii. Before initiating the allotment process, thoroughly verify the consent of affiliation of the University to which the colleges are affiliated.
- iv. Ensure that the candidates are well aware of the permission status of the allotted college, in case it is through interim orders. Further, during the reporting time, the college shall convey to the candidate that his/her admission through interim orders is only provisional and subject to the final outcome of the court order.
- v. Further, the Principal of the college shall submit Affidavit-cum-Undertaking to the State/UT Counselling Authority in the case where admission is based on seat/permission obtained by an interim order of the Court. **(Annexure-I is enclosed)**
- vi. In the case where admission is based on seat/permission obtained by interim order, the State/UT Counselling Authority shall ensure that the college has taken Affidavit-cum-Undertaking from the candidate during the admission process. **(Annexure-II is enclosed)**

Considering the candidates' future, All State/UT counselling authorities are instructed to strictly enforce these advisories for the smooth conduction of counselling for admission to UG&PG courses under ASU streams for the A.Y 2024-25.


